To the attention of the English-speaking persons of Delémont

INTRODUCTION

The municipality of Delémont is conducting a policy in view of limiting the waste production and promoting its sorting and recycling.

The municipality of Delémont organizes and supervises the elimination of the solid and liquid waste, more specifically of urban origin in the whole area of Delémont.

The municipality informs the population and the companies about the various possibilities of recycling and about the importance of a good waste administration.

ANNUAL TAX

An annual tax is raised to cover the costs of large rubbish, metal, glass, PET, paper and particularly for collecting, transporting, combusting and composting, together with the valorisation on any other rubbish recycling :

The annual tax for physical persons comes to :

The shops and companies have different tariffs according to their size.

BAG TAX

TAX COMING INTO EFFECT ON : 1st JULY 2001

A bag tax is raised to cover the expenses first of all for collecting, transporting and the combustion of the household rubbish.

From this date, only the **light grey**, closed taxed bags with the green overprint "**SEOD**" will be collected.

The charge for tax free bags amounts to :

- Frs. 1.10 per 17 litre bag
- Frs. 2.15 per 35 litre bag
- Frs. 3.85 per 60 litre bag
- Frs. 7.30 per 110 litre bag
- Frs. 393.60 per ton (for containers equipped with the SEOD microchip)

Special arrangements are intended for babies and persons suffering from incontinence.

The taxed bags are sold in rolls of 10 pieces in most shops of Delémont.

UNAUTHORIZED DEPOSITS

In the whole area of the municipality of Delémont it is forbidden to leave behind any kind of pollutant solid and liquid waste.

It is severely forbidden to deposit rubbish bags at the collecting points. Passing this prohibition is liable to a fine amounting to Frs. 100.-. Persons who use bags for the transportation of the recyclable waste like glass, PET, can, a.s.o. to collecting points are asked to take them back home.
