leave unneeded wrappings behind at the point of sale whenever possible

Aerosols

Can be left at the nearest collecting point (see attached map).

Aluminium and cans

Can be deposited at the nearest Collecting Point (see attached map).

Electrical and electronic appliances

Are accepted at the appropriate points of sale and also at : Fondation SENS/SWICO (024/424 20 44), Caritas Jura, Gobat SA, Met Fer SA, Stutzmann (see list of partners).

Cartons for drinks

May be put into taxed bags.

Wood

Can be left at Gobat SA or Met Fer SA (see list of partners) and will be charged.

Nespresso capsules

Can be taken to Stutzmann (see list of partners).

Carton (clean)

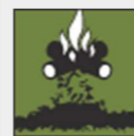
Carton should be tied up in bundles of no more than 18 kg.

Ink cartridges for printers

Can be returned to suppliers or put into taxed bags.

Compact Discs

Compact discs may be put into taxed bags.

Wood ash

May be put into taxed bags.

Material of composting

Flowers, peelings, fruits, vegetables, grass mowings, coffee grounds, teabags, garden waste, branches bound in bundles of maximum 1.5 m in length, and a diameter max 40 cm. Excluded are invasive plants and litter for animals.

Large objects (combustible)

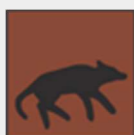
Furniture, bedsteads and underframes, mattresses, carpets, skis, empty vessels of up to 10 L, mirrors, windows, shutters, large toys, rolled carpeting (max. 1.5 m wide). Excluded : objects containing metal, waste from refurbishing of apartments.

Non-metallic and non-combustible items (small quantities)

Gobat SA or Met Fer SA (see list of partners).

Special household refuse


Potentially harmful substances are accepted free of charge by K + S Entsorgung in Delémont (032/423 16 62, on the 3rd Monday of each month, from 16h to 18h). For detailed information, apply to your Town Council Offices or consult www.jura.ch/env.

Dead animals

Animals remains are to be taken to the Centre for animalwaste, Soyhières, 032/422 13 94. Opening times : Mon-Sat, 9h30-11h30.

Ironware

Garden seats (no plastic), pots and pans, metal shelving, bicycles, piping, underframes (bed), metal framework, etc. Excluded : electrical and electronic appliances.

<p>Oils – mineral and vegetal</p>  <p>Can be deposited at the nearest Collecting Point (see attached map).</p>	<p>Pharmaceutics</p>  <p>Unused medicinal preparations can be returned to the supplier/point of sale.</p>
<p>Neons and fluorescent lamps</p>  <p>Can be returned to point of sale, and also to : SENS collecting centre (024/424 20 44), DELA SA, rue St-Henri 2 (industrial zone), Stutzmann (see list of partners).</p>	<p>Household rubbish</p>  <p>Unsorted household rubbish (i.e. not intended for selective collection) can be put into SEOD taxed bags (max. weight 18 kg). Larger quantities may be placed in containers equipped with SEOD microchips.</p>
<p>Paper</p>  <p>Dailies, magazines, books, sheet paper, shredded paper, duly tied in bundles of max. 18 kg. Excluded : carbonpaper and stencils, which can be included in taxed bags.</p>	<p>PET</p>  <p>PET bottles are to be returned to point of sale.</p>
<p>Batteries and accumulators</p>  <p>These are to be taken back to point of sale.</p>	<p>Plastic</p>  <p>Can be put into taxed bags.</p>
<p>Plastic (agricultural use)</p>  <p>Can be taken to Met Fer SA or Gobat SA (see list of partners) or also placed in containers equipped with SEOD microchips.</p>	<p>Tyres</p>  <p>Tyres are to be returned to the suppliers. A tax will be charged.</p>
<p>Sagex</p>  <p>Household: max. 30 L may be taken to rue St-Sébastien 5, on Mondays to Fridays. Firms : quantities over 30 L can be taken back to the supplier or to Caritas Jura.</p>	<p>Textiles</p>  <p>Textiles can be taken to the nearest Collecting Point. Special containers for textiles are available. They may also be set out for picking up during periodical rounds to collect textiles.</p>
<p>Glass</p>  <p>Glass can be taken to nearest Collecting Point (see attached map).</p>	<p>Automobile batteries</p>  <p>These are to be taken back to point of sale.</p>
